Employee Job Description

Distribution Laborer

Reports to: Distribution Superintendent
Grade: 4 (\$14.59 – \$16.64/hr.)

Department: Distribution
Classification: Hourly (non-exempt)

This is a full-time, entry-level position with typical working hours of M-F 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. The successful candidate will occasionally work off-shift hours, handle call-outs and serve on-call as needed.

Summary of Responsibilities:

This position provides skilled labor in assisting in the installation, maintenance, repair and replacement of water mains, hydrants, valves, meters and other related infrastructure on the water distribution system.

Essential Duties:

- Assist in the installation of mains and other pipes, water meters, valves, installing new water services/taps, reading meters, repair and maintenance of hydrants.
- Repair meters and ruptured water lines as needed.
- Assists with landscape restoration work.
- Clean and maintain equipment, tools and trucks.
- Perform maintenance on equipment and tools.
- Ensure that vehicles are stocked with tools and equipment.
- Operate various types of equipment and vehicles including light-duty trucks and tractors with mowers.
- Prepare reports, documents, and forms as required.
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Must have basic knowledge in the use of various hand tools, powered hand tools, and motorized equipment for general repair and maintenance work.
- A high school diploma or GED is required.
- An Ohio CDL Class A license is required or must be obtained within 12 months of hire date.
- A valid State of Ohio Motor Vehicle Operators License with an acceptable driving record is required until the CDL is obtained.
- Must be able and willing to perform manual labor in adverse weather conditions.
- Any combination of training and work experience, which indicates possession of the skills, knowledge and abilities to perform the job duties successfully.

Physical Demands:

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand, walk, and frequently required to stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl. The employee is frequently required to reach with hands and arms; and talk or hear. The employee is occasionally required to sit and climb or balance. The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to 25 pounds, frequently lift and/or move up to 50 pounds, and occasionally lift and/or move more than 100 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and ability to adjust focus.
